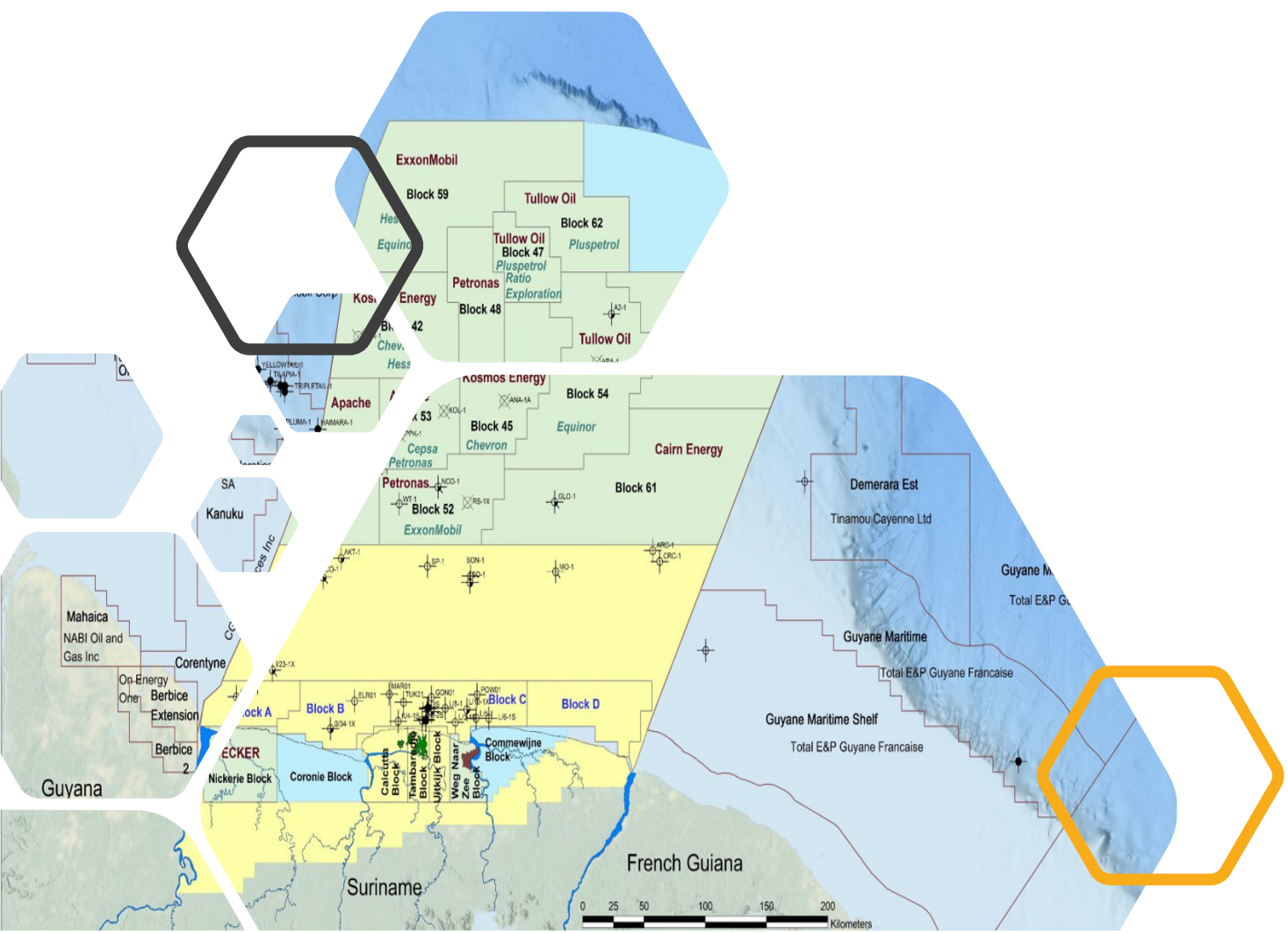

To fulfill this part of the Social Responsibility obligation as mentioned the PSCs, the Contractors implement the projects approved by SHI, who then monitors that the execution of the Social Responsibility projects is done in accordance with the approved project proposals and PSCs.

This report provides an overview of the Social Responsibility commitments and investments done by the Contractors between 2018 and 2020.



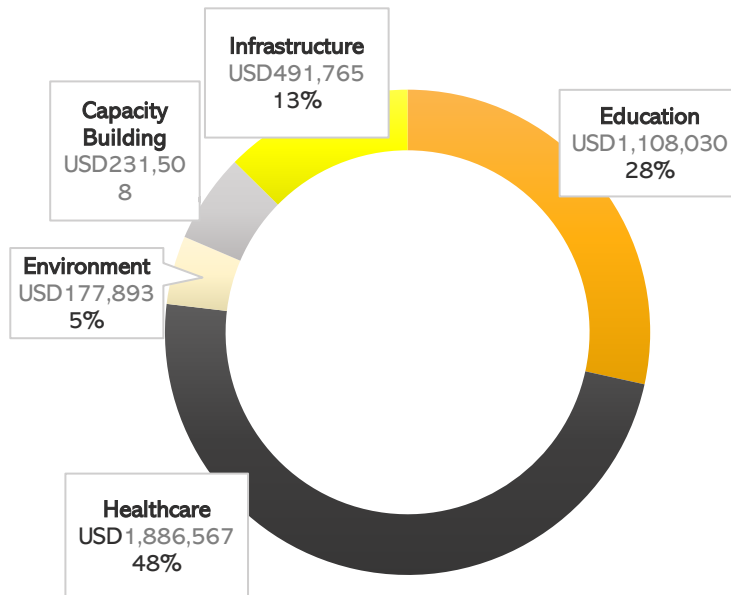
SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY FOCUS 2018 - 2020

The Social Responsibility projects approved and carried out between 2018-2020 are focused on 5 areas:

- **Healthcare**
Promoting healthcare and preventive healthcare, water and sanitation.
- **Education**
Promoting education and special education, enhancing vocational skills especially among children, women and elderly, renovation of schools.
- **Infrastructure**
The set-up of basic physical and organizational structures and facilities (e.g., buildings) needed for the sustainable support of socially vulnerable groups.
- **Capacity building**
Other livelihood enhancement projects and projects contributing to socio-economic development of minorities.
- **Environment**
Ensuring environmental sustainability, ecological balance, protection of flora and fauna, animal welfare, conservation of natural resources and maintaining quality of soil, air, and water.



Social Responsibility Expenditures 2018 - 2020 per area



Between 2018 and 2020 an amount of USD 3,895,763 was spent on the five (5) focus areas with the majority amount of USD 1,886,567 (48%) invested on Healthcare projects,

Hereafter a selection of the projects carried out between 2018-2020 will be highlighted per focus area.

1. Healthcare



Blood Bank Information System and Training of Information Technology staff

Aim

Replacement Blood Bank information system with new software designed for blood banks and that complies to international standards (including the training to users of the system).

Result

A successful replacement of the Blood Bank information system with new software to easily generate statistics and other reports. With this system Suriname can comply with International standards regarding Blood Banks which is a positive development for the National Health Care system.

Training provided to 34 users (authorized users, senior staff, IT staff (external)).

Project Cure: Funding transport & logistics medical supplies & equipment to medical mission clinics within the interior of Suriname

Aim

Mitigate some of the impact of the limited medical resources of the medical mission clinics of the interior of Suriname, by supplying these clinics with much needed medical supplies. This will help improve the health care in the interior.

Result

A 40 foot container with the specific needs of medical supplies was donated to the recipients clinics in the interior. Within this project, Apache funded the transportation and logistical costs of the distribution to the five (5) clinics in Sipaliwini-Tapanahony.

Su4Su Covid-19 Support

Aim

The local business society has taken the initiative to establish the 'Su4Su Covid-19 support fund' in order to mobilize the private sector in providing financial support to the Surinamese local healthcare institutions and their front line health personnel in order to help mitigate the impact of Covid-19 in Suriname.

Result

This project was successfully jointly executed by different IOCs and Staatsolie. Suriname's society appreciates the commitment of our contracting partners to the contribution of over USD 0,6 million to the 'Su4Su Covid-19 Support Fund' project. Medical equipment in order to fight against the COVID-19 pandemic was purchased and distributed.

2. Education



Upgrade of the Advanced UCIT Computer Rooms at ADEKUS

Aim

Upgrade the advanced ICT equipment that is required for the Sustainable Management of Natural Resources program at the Faculty of Technology of Sciences of the Anton de Kom University of Suriname.

Result

Delivered and installed 36 computers including power supply and HDMI cable at the Computer Rooms of ADEKUS.

NATIN Campus TVET Support 2019: Equipment needed for the ICT and Chemical Engineering programs of 3 schools

Aim

Investment in the technical skills and/or the practical experience of the workforce in order to participate in the Offshore petroleum industry.

Result

The IOCs and Staatsolie allocated a total budget of USD 0,6 million for the purchase of equipment and tools for the various study programs of three (3) schools. Furthermore for the administrative staff, offices furniture, computers, air conditioning units, PPE and fire extinguishers were funded. Lastly the fence of the NATIN Campus was renovated.

Math Battle 2019: Contribution to the advancement of practicing mathematics in Suriname

Aim

The Surinaamse Vereniging van Wiskunde- en Rekenleraren (SVWR) tries to contribute to the advancement of the practice of mathematics in Suriname and does so through organizing the National Math Olympiad for pupils at junior high school level. In 2019 the Math Battle was organized for the second time for pupils of thirteen (13) secondary schools.

Result

Execution of the second Math Battle at senior level, May 2019. This year students from eight (8) VWO schools participated in the contest. The school community of Kwatta won the Battle of 2019 with 420 points.

Aim

Result

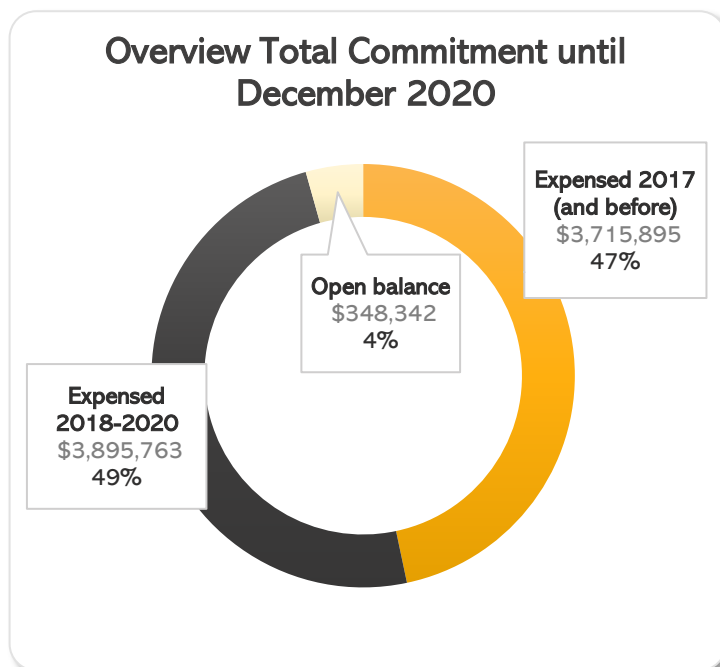
1. Training to the local NGO specifically to the STU activities and tourism promotion.

COMMITMENTS AND EXPENDITURES (DECEMBER 2020)

The yearly obligation is stipulated in the Production Sharing Contract. Over the period January 2010 up till December 2020 the Contractors were contractually committed to invest a total amount of USD 7,960,000 to the sustainable development of Suriname. For the purpose of this Report, this amount will be referred to as “Commitment”.



As of the starting date of this report, January 2018, there was an outstanding balance of USD 2,444,105 (40% of commitments from 2010-2018).

Most of these commitments were realized between 2018-2020 and overall 49% of the Total Commitment was invested between 2018 and 2020.

The table shows an overview of the Actual Expenditures and the balance per block as of the end of December 2020.
