

Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) Declaration

The Bidder declares that it is committed to conducting its activities in a safe, responsible, and environmentally sound manner and shall comply with all applicable Health, Safety, Environmental, maritime, and regulatory requirements relating to the purchase, transfer, transport/demobilization, operation, recycling, dismantling, or disposal of the Vessel and its attributes.

The Bidder further confirms that:

1. The intended use, operation, destination, or disposal of the Vessel shall be conducted in accordance with applicable national and international HSE requirements;
2. All necessary permits, licenses, approvals, and certifications required for the intended use or transfer of the Vessel shall be obtained by the Bidder at its own expense;
3. If the bidder uses subcontractors, towing companies, or other counterparties, the bidder remains responsible for ensuring they comply with the same HSE obligations;
4. Staatsolie may request evidence of permits, approvals, method statements, risk assessments, certificates, or disposal/recycling arrangements before completion or handover;
5. The Bidder shall take reasonable measures to prevent injury to persons, environmental pollution, and property damage arising from the transfer, operation, dismantling, or disposal of the Vessel; and
6. The Bidder shall indemnify and hold harmless Staatsolie from any claims, liabilities, penalties, environmental incidents, or damages arising after transfer of ownership of the Vessel to the Bidder in accordance with the Sale Agreement.
